

STUDENT TRAVEL SUPPORT GRANTS NEW JERSEY SPACE GRANT CONSORTIUM A NASA – Sponsored Program

The New Jersey Space Grant Consortium (NJSGC) is pleased to announce the availability of grants to undergraduate and graduate students in New Jersey colleges and universities for attending scientific conferences.

Application Procedures and Requirements

- A full-time graduate or undergraduate student in a New Jersey college or university can apply.
- The applicant is required to submit a proposal that describes the purpose of travel, including location, dates, sponsoring organization, and role of applicant (attendee, presenter of a paper, panelist, etc).
- The proposed travel must be in a STEM field and it must be relevant to the research being conducted by the applicant. Higher preference will be given to travel to conferences involving space science or aerospace.
- The grant amount is up to \$500 per award. Higher preference will be given to graduate students.
- The academic institution of the student must match the grant amount by at least 120%.
- By NASA mandate, only U.S. citizens are eligible to apply.
